

# A WORD FOR TODAY FROM UNITED CHRISTIAN BROADCASTERS FOR MAY 2023



- 1<sup>st</sup>. Psalm 25 V1:- 'Unto to thee O Lord, do I lift up my soul'. When you need help, note what David did He knew who to turn to he knew who to trust he knew how to pray, allowing God to change & transform him. Make prayer a natural response rather than a last resort.
- **2<sup>nd</sup>.** Ephesians 1 V9:- 'God made known to us the mystery of his will.' In his presence we can receive insights which gives us purpose, hope, dignity, direction, & the strength to proceed without fear for what God has promised us in His word.
- **3<sup>rd</sup>.** Genesis 37 V3, 39 V12, & 41 V42:- 'Israel (Jacob) loved Joseph & made him a coat of many colours' 3 that presents a picture of <u>our</u> life as Christians:- One of <u>Salvation</u>, a gift of grace a coat of <u>temptation</u> & God's forgiveness from the Cross & a coat of <u>destiny</u>, where his trials were times of training & perseverance for his future victory & assignment.
- **4<sup>th</sup>.** 1 Peter 2 V20:- 'If you suffer for doing good---& endure---this is commendable before God, 'because Christ suffered for us, that we should follow in his steps, 'Called' to overcome difficulties. Ask God to help us remember that He is working for our good & His glory.
- **5**<sup>th</sup>. Galatians 5 V1:- 'Christ has truly set us free---make sure that you stay free,' a warning from Paul for us Not to get tied up again in slavery to the law to train ourselves to worry less about what people think, & pleasing them rather, about what God thinks about us.
- **6<sup>th</sup>.** Ephesians 2 V10:- 'For we are—created---for good works. As God's co-workers we are called to seek his guidance & will in all our decisions. To identify our life's purpose, ask ourselves what am I searching for? why was I created? do I believe in my potential? & when should I start? The answer is Now.
- **7<sup>th</sup>.** Psalm 89 V34:- 'My Covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips.' If you sometimes wake up and feel the day ahead is going to be a gloomy one, turn to God's living Word- the one source of strength & hope that never fails.

- **8**<sup>th</sup>. Ecclesiastes 9 V10:- 'Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might.' What ever you are doing right now might seem dull, insignificant & unrewarding but it could be preparing you for something God wants to do through you in the future. Aim to maximise each opportunity & relationship that comes your way today & every day.
- **9**<sup>th</sup>. Philippians 3 V8:- I have suffered the loss of all things, & count them as rubbish, that I may gain Christ' says Paul. When we are willing to fellowship with Christ in His suffering, we will get to experience the power of His resurrection so be totally committed to Him.
- **10<sup>th</sup>.** Lamentations 3 V40:- 'Let us examine our ways--- & return to the Lord,' Pray that the Lord will make you a better person, showing you in what specific areas of your life you need to change, grow & mature. This calls for honesty & determination to get real with God.
- 11<sup>th</sup>. Exodus 18 V23:- 'If you do this—you will be able to stand the strain.' Sometimes we insist on doing everything ourselves denying others the opportunity to learn. Better to find the right person, give them the job enabling them to succeed, & trust them to do the right thing.
- **12<sup>th</sup>.** Acts 16 V14:- 'Lydia, a successful business women—the Lord opened her heart, & she accepted what Paul was saying.' God can do the same for each one of us, as He already has a plan for our lives. He is looking for co-workers willing to help fulfil it, for his glory.
- **13th.** Psalm 84 V11:- 'No good thing will God withhold from those who walk uprightly.' It is easy to think the more we give, the less we will have, but our logic is back to front! We ultimately lose what we keep, & ultimately keep whatever we lose for the cause of serving Christ.
- **14<sup>th</sup>.** Job 23 V9:- 'I catch no glimpse of Him.' In difficult times it is hard to sense God's presence. Difficult days demand decisions of faith, so when we can't understand the ways of God trust in the unchanging & loving character of God, whose will is right, holy & perfect.
- **15<sup>th</sup>.** 2 Kings 2 V9:- 'Elisha said to Elijah let a double portion of your spirit be upon me.' We too can receive the same of God's spirit, if we meet the conditions:- by staying close to Him saying NO to our carnal nature, cling to God's vision for our life, & surrender ALL to him.

- **16**<sup>th</sup>. Proverbs 18 V24:- 'A true friend sticks by you like family.' Someone who understands, especially one who has been in the same situation as yours who has fought the same battles in life, & come out on the winning side.
- 17<sup>th</sup>. Isaiah 41 V10:- 'Do not be dismayed, for I am your God--- I will strengthen & help you uphold you with my right hand. 'In this situation, find someone to comfort & lift you up, & refuse to accept defeat, get up and try again. Ask God to give you strength to keep going to persevere until you win.
- **18**<sup>th</sup>. Hebrews 12 V2:- 'He Jesus never lost sight of where He was headed, '- willing to put up with anything along the way the Cross shame, whatever. A call for us Not to lose our passion, but to harness our spiritual energy, & allow God redirect it for His kingdom.
- **19<sup>th</sup>.** 1 Peter 1 V7:- 'These trials will show your faith is genuine they reveal both our weaknesses & strengths telling us how much God cares for us how we act when we are under pressure & to believe that God will bring us out with a mighty hand, even when the enemy oppresses.
- **20<sup>th</sup>.** 1 Peter 5 V7:- 'Let him have all your worries & cares ,' as Jesus is constantly thinking about us & watching all our concerns. We pray for people who are so stressed, that they feel they are at breaking point. May they entrust what they cannot handle to God.
- **21**<sup>st</sup>. Habakkuk 3 V18:- 'Yet I will rejoice in the Lord' who in the midst of adversity, adopted an attitude of gratefulness. In times of trouble, may we recall God's faithfulness, give thanks for the many blessings we have received then our outlook & attitude will change.
- **22**<sup>nd</sup>. Romans 12 V6:- 'Having gifts & talents that differ according to the grace given us, let us use them. God has given us experiences, skills & attributes for us to build His kingdom. Success is doing the best we can, with what we have, using every opportunity in his service.
- **23**<sup>rd</sup>. Ephesians 4 V31:- 'Let all bitterness--- be put away from you.' It is tempting to hold grudges & resentment against someone who has wrongly mistreated us, but in the end. <u>We</u>, will be miserable, & unable to offer forgiveness & reconciliation.

- **24**<sup>th</sup>. Hebrews 12 V3:- 'Consider Him who endured such opposition.' Jesus never allowed criticism or discouragement to defeat him every obstacle was an opportunity to demonstrate grace, to show compassion & love to others. May we live generously & graciously despite opposition.
- 25<sup>th</sup>. Psalm 19 V1:- 'The heavens are telling the glory of God a marvellous display of His craftmanship.' He is the great designer temperature, enabling humankind & animals to live oxygen, the precise balance of air we need to breath our earth rotates 365 times a year as we pass around the sun. At creation God revealed his great power, & his great love on the cross. Pray for those who don't yet know the great designer.
- **26<sup>th</sup>.** Job 5 V26:- 'You will come to the grave in full vigour' The bible is full of stories of people who stayed active in mind & body, living on because they had plenty to live for. Pray for those who feel they're too old to be used by God. May they have a desire to accept new challenges.
- **27<sup>th</sup>.** Proverbs 17 V17:- A friend loves at all times, & a brother is born for adversity.' Avoid living in despair & depression if unable to cope. Shame & quilt can prevent us from letting others know what we are struggling with. Pray for those who need courage to ask for help.
- **28<sup>th</sup>.** Philippians 4 V4:- 'Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, Rejoice.' Our attitude is something we can choose to change regardless of our circumstances. It is easy to lapse into negativity true joy is an inside attitude that is not affected by people or outside situations.
- **29**<sup>th</sup>. Psalm 51 V15:- 'My mouth shall show forth Your praise.' A grateful heart sees each day as a precious gift to be used, being thankful for each & every blessing. Rejoicing over the good things in life, is what can help us through the hard times.
- **30**<sup>th</sup>. Philippians 2 V13:- 'It is God who works in you---to act according to his good purpose'. As we travel through life on our spiritual journey, remember that with God no experience is ever wasted, that includes the painful & difficult ones. Also, to succeed in God's kingdom, we are called to serve others, with a determination to keep moving forward in faith.
- **31**<sup>st</sup>. 2 Corinthians 10 V4:- 'The weapons of our warfare are --- mighty in God for pulling down strongholds.' A pattern of evil passes from one generation to the next the Bible refers to it as a 'stronghold.' Pray for people who are struggling to move on from their past.

Synopsis of the Minutes of the Meeting of Dunkeswell Parish Council held in the Village Hall on 17th April 2023

Next meeting - 22nd May

Dunkeswell Village Hall, 7.30pm

#### **Public Open Session**

Regarding Planning item 23/06 c, A member of the Allotment Association attended and the Council confirmed that the application is one shed per whole plot, that sheds would be no larger than 6x8, would be of a wooden construction, different shapes and sizes as indicated in the application, No permanent foundations. The Allotment Committee will agree what is acceptable and keep all shed placements under review. Clerk to email contact details for WIMs and the Allotment Association to write to keep WIMs informed, being the landowner.

Cllr Key offered to look into the large amount of earth/soil that has been delivered to the site, since the building works commenced North of Louis Way and as to whether a license to move the earth has been gained by the construction company.



Turn off that tap! Customers could soon be told by their water supply companies how much water they can use over a year for their washing, cooking, cleaning and gardening!

Water companies are set to increase charges for households who use more than their 'recommended annual ration' for washing, cooking, cleaning and gardening.

People who use high levels of water would be charged an extra 160 % -going up from £1.50 per 1,000 litres to £4 - while those who are careful with their usage could make savings.

During the summer months when water supplies are scare, customers could be charged even more, to stop them from using too much. Some households could qualify for discounts if they have a water butt in the garden, or have permeable parking on their property.

These schemes are being promoted by the industry regulator Ofwat which says it wants water companies to be more 'creative' in how they set charges to 'help encourage customers to use water wisely'.

Affinity Water, which supplies water to 3.8million people across the South East, will be the first to run trials of differential pricing for 1,500 customers this year.

Under its scheme, customers will get the first 30,000 litres of water they use for free, around two months' supply for a four-person household.

#### **Boots Advantage points to be reduced from May 2023:**

Boots is cutting the number of Advantage points it gives card holders from May, from four points per pound to three points per pound. Every point will still be worth 1p to spend in-store. You'll still be able to earn double points during your birthday month, although this will fall from eight points per pound to six points per pound.

# Could you apply for financial help from the Household Support Fund?

An extra £842m is being allocated through the Household Support Fund until 31 March 2024, to help households who are struggling to manage their living costs. The amount you may be able to claim from your local council will depend on where you live and whether you meet eligibility requirements. Apply through your local council.

#### NHS prescriptions going up in price:

The price of an NHS prescription in England has risen by 30p from April, taking the cost from £9.35 to £9.65. This is an increase of 3.2% overall and is the first rise in two years after the price was frozen in last April last year.



The Government introduced the freeze, which was the first time in 12 years, due to the cost-of-living crisis.

Alongside this, the cost of prescription prepayment certificates (PPCs) - which cover multiple NHS prescriptions for a set price - will also increase. A three-month PPC is going up from £30.25 to £31.25, and a 12-month PPC will increase from £108.10 to £111.60.

The cost of wigs and fabric supports will rise as well, while the recently introduced PPC for Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT) will cost £19.30.

There are several ways you can try to reduce the cost of your medication and you should check to see if any would benefit you before paying.

#### Check if you get free prescriptions

#### Certain medical conditions

There are ways you can cut down the cost of your medicine and the first place to start is by checking if you need to pay for prescriptions at all. Some people in England are entitled to free prescriptions, and include the following groups:

- You're aged 60 or over
- You're aged under 16 or are 17 or 18 and in full-time education
- You're pregnant or had a baby in the previous 12 months and have a valid maternity exemption certificate
- You have a specific medical condition and have a valid medical exemption card
- You have a continuing physical disability that prevents you from going out without help from another person and has a valid medical exemption certificate (MedEx)
- You hold a valid war pension exemption certificate and the prescription is for your accepted disability
- You are an NHS inpatient

Medical exemption certificates are only given to those who have specific medical conditions or disabilities

Medical exemption certificates are only given to those with a specific health condition that meets the NHS's qualifying criteria for additional support.

According to the NHS's Business Service Authority (NHSBSA), to get one you must have one of the following conditions.

#### These include:

- Cancer
- A permanent fistula which needs continuous surgical dressing or an appliance
- A form of hypoadrenalism which requires specific substitution therapy
- Diabetes insipidus or other forms of hypopituitarism
- Diabetes mellitus, except where treatment is by diet alone
- Hypoparathyroidism
- Myasthenia gravis
- Myxoedema
- Epilepsy requiring continuous anticonvulsive therapy

#### Claiming certain benefits

You can also get free prescriptions if you or your partner are claiming certain benefits, (see below) or if you're aged under 20 and dependent on someone claiming certain benefits, including:

- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Pension Credit Guarantee Credit
- Universal Credit all meet the criteria

You may also be able to get free prescriptions if you are entitled to an NHS tax credit exemption certificate.

To get one of these, you need to qualify for child tax credits or working tax credits, including a disability or severe disability element, and have an income of less than £15,276 a year.

#### Save with a Prescription Prepayment Certificate (PPC)

If you don't qualify for free prescriptions then you may benefit from getting a **Prescription Prepayment Certificate**.

The PPC is often referred to as a "season ticket" for prescriptions as you pay for a three-month pass or a 12-month, and you can get as many prescriptions as you need in that time.

Even though the price of the PPCs has gone from April, it can still work out cheaper if you pay for regular medication.

From April:

- A three-month PPC will cost £31.25
- A 12-month PPC will cost £111.60

#### Help towards costs if you're on a low income

If you don't qualify for free prescriptions with any of these schemes, you could still get some help towards costs if you are on a low income. How much help you get is dependent on your circumstances and income and this includes your outgoings and any savings you have. If you have a low income, the **NHS Low Income Scheme** could help you pay for:

- NHS prescription charges
- NHS dental treatment charges
- the cost of sight tests, glasses and contact lenses
- the cost of travelling to receive NHS treatment

NHS wigs and fabric supports (check with your hospital for their arrangements for supplying NHS wigs)

#### Save by paying over the counter

If you're prescribed common medication such as painkillers or dermatology creams that are also available over the counter, often it's cheaper to buy them that way rather than pay for a prescription. If you are doing this, then you should also consider **generic** medicines rather than big-brand versions.

Most of the time it is the medicine's active ingredient that matters, and a lot of the time these are found in a shop's "own brand" medicines.

# What is a **Coronation?**

A coronation is both the symbolic religious ceremony during which a sovereign is crowned and the physical act of placing a crown on a monarch's head.

It formalises the monarch's role as the head of the Church of England and marks the transfer of their title and powers.

However, it is not actually necessary for the monarch to be crowned to become King.

Edward VIII reigned without a coronation - and Charles automatically became King the moment Queen Elizabeth II died.

#### What happens at a coronation?

Coronations have remained much the same for more than 1,000 years. The British ceremony is the only remaining event of its type in Europe. However, Buckingham Palace has said that although the coronation will be "rooted in long-standing traditions", it will also "reflect the monarch's role today and look towards the future".

It is likely to be shorter and smaller in scale than Queen Elizabeth II's 1953 coronation, with a wider range of religions represented.

The coronation procession is also expected to be more modest. Queen Elizabeth's procession had 16,000 participants and took 45 minutes to pass any stationary point on the 7km (4.3 miles) route.

This time, the King and Camilla, the Queen Consort, will travel to West-minster Abbey in the King's procession, and return to Buckingham Palace in a larger coronation procession, where they will be joined by other members of the Royal Family.

#### There are several stages to the service:

**The recognition:** While standing beside the 700-year-old Coronation Chair, the monarch is presented to those gathered in the Abbey by the Archbishop of Canterbury. The congregation shouts "God Save the King!" and trumpets sound

**The oath:** The sovereign swears to uphold the law and the Church of England

The anointing: The King's ceremonial robe is removed and he sits in the Coronation Chair. A gold cloth is held over the chair to conceal the King from view. The Archbishop of Canterbury anoints the King's hands, breast and head with holy oil made according to a secret recipe, but known to contain ambergris, orange flowers, roses, jasmine and cinnamon. The oil created for Charles will not contain any ingredients derived from animals The investiture: The sovereign is presented with items including the Royal Orb, representing religious and moral authority; the Sceptre, representing power; and the Sovereign's Sceptre, a rod of gold topped with a white enamelled dove, a symbol of justice and mercy. Finally, the Archbishop places St Edward's Crown on the King's

**The enthronement and homage:** The King leaves the Coronation Chair and moves to the throne. Peers kneel before the monarch to pay homage The Queen Consort will then be anointed in the same way and crowned.

#### Who will go to the coronation?

The coronation is a state occasion, which means the government controls the guest list.

In addition to the Royal Family, those attending will include the prime minister, representatives from the Houses of Parliament, heads of state, and other royals from around the world.

More than 8,000 guests attended Queen Elizabeth II's coronation, but Westminster Abbey had to be closed for five months to allow extra seating to be built.

Its normal capacity is about 2,200 and it seems likely this will be the maximum number on this occasion.







#### **CONDENSED MILK BISCUITS.**

#### Ingredients:

250 g margarine/butter

3/4 cup sugar

1 pinch salt

3 cups flour (sifted)

1 (397gm) can sweetened

condensed milk

1/2 teaspoon vanilla essence

10mls baking powder



#### Method:

Cream butter and sugar until soft and creamy.

Beat in vanilla essence and condensed milk.

Gradually add sifted flour, salt and baking powder until mixture is a firm but workable dough. (If mixture is very stiff do not add all the flour)

Wrap the dough in wax paper and put into the fridge for 1/2 hour.

Roll dough into balls the size of a walnut, place on a greased bak-

ing tray and flatten gently with a fork.

Bake at 180° C for 10 to 12 minutes until light golden brown.

This recipe makes approximately 60+ biscuits.




# World Turtle Day is May 23!



- **1.** Turtles belong to one of the oldest reptile groups in the world beating snakes, crocodiles and alligators!
- **2.** These creatures date back to the time of the dinosaurs, over 200 million years ago wow!
- **3.** Turtles are easily recognised by their bony, cartilaginous **shell**. This tough casing acts like a shield to protect them from predators some turtles can even tuck their head up inside their shell for extra protection!
- **4.** Just like your bones, a turtle's shell is actually part of its skeleton. It's made up of over **50 bones** which include the turtle's **rib cage** and **spine**.
- **5.** Contrary to popular belief, a turtle cannot come out of its shell. The turtle's shell grows with them, so it's impossible for them to grow too big for it!
- **6.** What a turtle eats depends on the environment it lives in. Land-dwelling turtles will munch on **beetles**, **fruit** and **grass**, whereas sea dwellers will gobble everything from **algae** to **squid** and **jellyfish**.
- **7.** Some turtles are **carnivores** (meat eaters), others are **herbivores** (plant eaters) and some are **omnivores** (a mixture of the two!). Many baby turtles start life as carnivores but grow to eat more plants as they mature.
- **8.** Turtles are 'amniotes' they breathe air and lay their eggs on land, although many species live in or around water.
- **9.** These cold-blooded creatures have an incredibly long life span. The oldest ever recorded, named **Tu"i Malila**, of Tonga Island, passed away at the grand old age of **188**!
- **10.** Sadly, many species of turtle are endangered! **129** of approximately 300 species of turtle and tortoise on Earth today are either vulnerable, endangered, or critically endangered. Threats include loss of habitat, pollution, poaching and the illegal pet trade.


